WARNINGS:

PRECAUTIONS:

- Do not inhale fumes or spray mist.
- Wear face mask and protective clothing (overall, rubber boots and gloves) during mixing and applying.
- In case of accidental skin contact, wash thoroughly with soap and water.
- Wash contaminated clothing daily.
- Do not eat, drink or smoke whilst mixing or applying or before washing hands and face and change of clothing after use.
- Prevent contamination of feedstuff, food, eating utensils and drinking water.
- Prevent drift of spray mist onto other crops, grazing, rivers, dam or areas not under treatment.
- Rinse empty container three times with a volume of water equal to a minimum of 10% of that of the container. Add the
 rinsings to the contents of the spray tank before destroying the container in the prescribed manner.
- Destroy empty container by perforation and flattening and never use for any other purpose.
- Do not drink any form of alcohol 24 hours before, during and 24 hours after spraying of this product since alcohol increases the irritation effect of DEURBRAAK.

SYMPTOMS OF HUMAN POISONING:

Irritation of mucous membranes, redness of the face, vertigo, increased respiration, increased pulse rate and hypotension. Symptoms usually disappear after a short while but may last up to 24 hours in extreme cases. Symptoms are increased by the consumption of alcohol.

FIRST AID TREATMENT:

Remove person from source of poisoning and keep him/her still and reassured.

EYES: Flush eyes with copious amounts of water for at least 15 minutes.

SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Rinse contaminated body area thoroughly with plenty of soap and

cold water. Do not rub skin.

INHALATION: Remove person to fresh air. If breathing is difficult give oxygen. If not breathing give artificial respiration.

INGESTION: Give one or two glasses of water or milk to drink. Do not induce vomiting.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

No known antidote. Treat symptomatically.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use only as directed.

Apply as a direct spray with complete coverage of buds where rest breaking is sought. Where applicable, apply after pruning.

COMPATIBILITY: DEURBRAAK is not compatible with insecticides or fungicides and should not be used in tank mixes with these products.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Make up solutions as indicated below by half filling the spray tank, with clean water then start agitation and add the required amount of DEURBRAAK. Fill with water to the required volume.
- 2. Use a hand gun or a knapsack sprayer equipped with D4 nozzles and 45 whirlplates. Spray at low pressure (<100 kPa).
- 3. For bearing trees, volumes of water should be determined by the tree row volume formula.

Apples: Volumes should not exceed 1 000l/ha.

Apricots and Plums: Volumes should not exceed 750l/ha.

Notes:

i) Do not apply by brush, hand spray or sponge as this may lead to erratic results as well as uneven application.

ii) Do not leave spray mixture to stand overnight.
